

Foundations of Assessment and Analyzing K-12 Reading Data

Appropriately assessing our readers and knowing how to analyze that data is the first step in determining how to meet the learning needs for all students. This workshop will focus on types of assessment data and their purposes in building a student's reading assessment portfolio, and also build the participant's understanding of how to use that data to identify the learning targets for reading interventions. Participants will have an opportunity to draft a plan for developing and implementing regular and focused data team meetings throughout the course of the academic year. 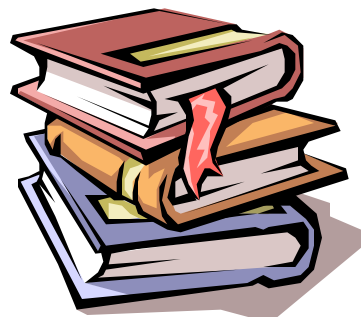
